Abstract


Complex systems represented by multivariate time series are ubiquitous in many applications, especially in industry. Understanding a complex system, its states and their evolution over time is a challenging task. This is due to the permanent change of contextual events internal and external to the system. We are interested in **representing** the evolution of a complex system in an intelligible and explainable way based on knowledge extraction.

We propose XR-CSB (eXplainable Representation of Complex System Behavior) based on three steps:

- a time series vertical clustering to detect system states,
- an explainable visual representation using unfolded finite-state automata and
- (iii) an explainable pre-modeling based on an enrichment via exploratory metrics.

Four representations adapted to the expertise level of domain experts for acceptability issues are proposed. Experiments show that XR-CSB is scalable. Qualitative evaluation by experts of different expertise levels shows that XR-CSB meets their expectations in terms of explainability, intelligibility and acceptability. 
1) Vertical clustering: independent of the size of time series ==> complexity control

explanatory metrics, speed, velocity, acceleration




